

North Nova Education Centre Introduces Paperless Report Cards

We are excited to announce that North Nova Education Centre will be piloting the new paperless reporting pilot for grades 9 to 12 beginning with the April mid-term report card. We invite you to participate in this pilot. You now have the opportunity to “**Opt In**” and access a paperless report card in place of a paper copy.

You will be able to print the report card from home or save the report card as a PDF document. The report card will be accessible to you online in the PowerSchool Parent Portal.

Why paperless?

It’s an environmentally friendly way to access your child’s educational information including their report card. **If you decide to participate in the paperless pilot, you will not receive a paper copy of the report card in April and June.**

Unfortunately, IPP report cards are not yet available in a paperless format. If your child receives an IPP report card, you will continue to receive this from the school as a paper copy. However, you will still have access to your child’s educational information on-line.

When will report cards be available in the Portal?

The online version of the report card will be available on the same day that paper report cards are distributed to students (April 24th & June 28th).

How can I “Opt In” to the paperless report card?

You can “**Opt In**” by informing the school that you wish to **ONLY** receive a paperless report card for the remainder of the school year.

If you already have a Parent Portal account you can inform the school by calling 902-755-8180 ext 0 or emailing Mrs. Lohead at locheadd@ccrce.ca.

If you do not have a Portal account yet, your first step is to contact the school (as listed above) and we will provide you with the necessary information you need to create your own account.

How long are report cards available online?

Report cards for only the current school year will be available in the Portal, so if you wish to have a permanent copy of the report card for your records, ensure to either print or save the report card before the Portal closes for the school year. This generally occurs in early July.

How do I access the report card?

When you log in to the web browser version of the Parent Portal, a new link entitled ‘Report Card’ will appear on the navigation bar on the left side of the page.

Paperless report cards must be accessed using the web browser version of the Portal. Paperless report cards will not be available through the mobile app on your smart phone or mobile device.

What does the report card look like?

The paperless report card looks slightly different from the paper version that you are accustomed to receiving, however, you will still find all essential information you need. This is a sample of the paperless report card.
