### SAFETY POSTER CONTEST

**1<sup>ST</sup> DIVISION OPEN TO ALL INDIVIDUALS WITH INTELLECTUAL DISABILITIES (who are in special needs classes in a public school or in a dedicated facility)**

**2<sup>nd</sup> DIVISION OPEN TO ALL PUBLIC and PRIVATE STUDENTS UNDER 19 (HIGH SCHOOL)**

**\*SPONSORING COUNCIL: PICTONIAN 879\***

**Subject:** Only posters with the subject of safety (i.e. substance abuse, Internet and social media misuse, cell phone safety, weather and fire safety, etc.) will be considered.

**Contest Levels:** Judging is done in three levels: Lower - Grades 3, 4 & 5, Middle - Grades 6, 7 & 8, Upper - Grades 9 - 12.

### CONTEST RULES

All posters must be prepared on art board or bristol board 22" x 28" at least 4 ply or greater.

The entrant must do all of the original artwork, **ONLY ONE POSTER PER STUDENT** is admissible. Computer generated items and paste on items from magazines, made from construction paper, etc., is allowed.

Poster fronts should contain no identifying marks of any nature. Instead, **the artist's name, home address, school, level, and the sponsoring council MUST be placed in an envelope and attached to the back of the poster.**

The envelope will be opened only after judging is completed at the local level. After the local council notes the winner's information, the identification card will be placed back in the envelope before submission to the regional council.

Posters will be judged as follows: Originality of idea - up to 50%, artistic ability displayed - up to 40%, neatness - up to 10%.

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winner will go to the Regional Level.

**\*\* NOTE:** if your poster wins 1<sup>st</sup> at the Regional Level in May not only is there a cash award but, it will be sent to the International Level. Cash awards at the international level are 1<sup>st</sup> - \$100.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$75.00 and 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$50.00

**DEADLINE FOR POSTERS IS APRIL 15<sup>TH</sup>.** Pick up can be arranged.

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
